As a part of our CSR initiatives, keeping in view the importance and necessity of quality technical education and promotion of skill development programs for poverty reduction, we have supported Sri.V.R. Polytechnic college, Tiruvottiyur. Increased training capacity and improved infrastructure to technical institutes will enhance quality of training to students. For this purpose, we have procured 20 desktop computers with updated software & hardware technology for Computer Engineering department. With this, every year 200 students and around 40 school dropout were trained in software & hardware courses.



For improving practical knowledge to Electrical & Mechanical students, procured Control panel boards, Shunt motor with spring balance, motor speed indicators, Transformers 3KVA / Phase etc. With this, every year 270 students and 20-30 dropouts are getting trained.
