# DISTRIBUTION OF PROVISIONS IN MUKTYALA VILLAGE

In the wake of spreading of Novel Carona virus in India and its declaration as pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Government of India declared this contagious disease as a Notified Disaster. To curtail further spreading of Carona virus in the country, Government of India imposed total lockdown from 21st Mach 2020 onwards. Due to this lockdown, some of people those who are working as daily wage workers, agriculture labourers etc., have lost their livelihood and subjected to great hadrships.

In order to support these needy and helpless poor people during the lockdown period, Company has procured 700 Nos. of grocery kits containing 10 KG Rice, Tamarind 500 grams, Oil - -1 KG, Sugar – 1 KG, Red gram -1 KG & Bombay Ravva – 1KG and distributed the same.

These grocery items were distributed to each and every household in Muktyala village. During distribution, awareness was created amongst Muktyala villagers on the dangerous effects of Corona Virus (Covid-19) and the measures to be taken by each individual to control its spreading.

#### **DEMAND SURVEY FOR SKILL TRAININGS**

As a part of our CSR initiatives and to develop Skills amongst the youth, demand survey has been conducted for the village youth in the surrounding villages. This project has been entrusted to TMI e2E academy, Hyderabad to conduct demand survey and to identify requisite Skill training programs along with employment opportunities in 5 villages (Muktyala, Vajinepelli, K. Agraharam, Jayanthipuram & Vedadri).

During the survey, the team has interacted with around 259 Nos. youth, 143 Nos. village stake holders and few industries, Employment officers, employment hubs in and around Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam, Bangalore and Hyderabad. After the survey, TMI e2E academy has recommended few high demand skill training courses which suites the targeted youth. Eg: Electrician cum AC technician, Fitter & specialized computer courses, Picker & Packer courses that provide quick placement opportunities.
